



Dear Prospective Food Vendor,

Welcome to the 163rd Annual Faribault County Fair, Wednesday, July 24 - Saturday, July 27. The Fair hours will be Wednesday - Friday 11am to 10pm, and Saturday 11am to 8pm.

The Faribault County Fair Board is planning for another exciting fair schedule and we would like to invite you to be a part of it! Exhibitors and vendors are an important part of the fair because of the education and the services that they provide to fair goers.

Space is now available for you to reserve if you would like to sell your food or products at our fair at a cost of \$250. If you require 220 electricity, an additional \$50 is required. Please provide your own power cords, tables, etc. Applying soon will help us reserve a space for you. Setup is Monday or Tuesday, July 22 or 23 until 8pm. Breakdown can begin after 8pm on Saturday or any time Sunday, July 28.

To help reduce the traffic on the grounds, please have your food and supplies in place by 11am each day of the fair and park in the designated vendor parking areas.

Each vendor will receive one free parking pass for the week. Additional parking passes can be purchased in the Fair office for \$6. Electricity is available for an additional fee. Please specify your needs on the following form along with payment.

You will need to supply your own extension cords, hoses, tables and chairs.

FOR RETURNING VENDORS: We will not guarantee your same spot as last year if we do not receive your completed application and payment by June 1.

BY STATE LAW: Food vendors are not allowed to have any pets/animals in the vending areas.

ALCOHOL POLICY: At no time shall a vendor sell, distribute or possess alcohol anywhere on the fairgrounds except within the Beer Garden and Grandstand area and/or otherwise noted by fair board staff.

We look forward to seeing you at the Faribault County Fair!


